Asbestos Awareness Training Programme
(Reg. 10 – Control of Asbestos Regulations 2012)

Introduction

The HSE require that, “Asbestos Awareness training is required to be given to employees whose work could foreseeable expose them to asbestos. In particular, it should be given to all demolition workers and those workers in the refurbishment, maintenance and allied trades where it is foreseeable that their work will disturb the fabric of the building”.

Annual refresher training is also required.

Who should attend

Asbestos Awareness training is for those persons who are liable to be exposed to asbestos while carrying out their normal everyday work, such as:

General maintenance staff	Electricians
Plumbers	Gas fitters
Painters and decorators	Joiners
Plasterers	Demolition workers
Construction workers	Roofers
Heating & ventilating engineers	Engineers
Fire and burglar alarm installers	Computer installers
Building surveyors and shop fitters
